Decking the Sanctuary for Advent & Christmas!

*Purchasing the poinsettias for our sanctuary
will be different this year.*

20 poinsettias will be purchased from Jarrett's Jungle.

This purchase will be done through the church office. Meaning you will give a check to Mt. Tabor, the office will receive a bill from Jarrett's Jungle and will make the payment. The poinsettias will be delivered on December 21st by Jarrett's Jungle.

10 poinsettias will be "on your own" purchases.

This purchase will be made by you from your choice of retailer. The poinsettia will need to be brought to the sanctuary the morning of December 21st. You will need to put your name on it so you will know it is yours for pickup. Additionally, the poinsettia will need to be wrapped in green foil and have a red bow. You will need to contact the church office to add your name to the list. This will ensure there is a spot available for your poinsettia.
