Council Highlights:

- Minutes were unanimously approved.
- A motion was made to begin renovation of the Men's Restroom across from the Nursery at a cost of \$35,000-\$45,000. The work will be done by Get Real Roofing, the company who did a great job on the renovations of the 2 bathrooms for ladies. The motion passed unanimously.
- The Endowment Fund request form has been updated and was approved by Council.
- The purchase of a "Building Community. Sharing God's Love" banner, which encourages those who use the park to make a contribution, and will hang on the sign near the park, was approved by Council.
- Bob Livingston recommended that Travis Spainhour replace Wade Roof on the Edward Jones Account. Beth Branham seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Pastoral Ponderings

*“The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ,
the love of God, and the communion of
the Holy Spirit be with all of you.”*

2 Cor. 13:13

On my first official Sunday as your Pastor, January 5, 2014, I came through the doors of the church, a nervous wreck. I had no idea what to expect. I had, what felt like minimal experience. I had no idea who any of you actually were, and I had very little confidence in myself to do what you were asking me to do as the 20th pastor of MTLC.

What I found in this congregation, was love, grace, welcome, and a willingness to walk together in ministry. I found strong leadership in this place that taught me how to step out in faith, knowing that Christ would go with us. I found friendships and partnerships that pointed to Jesus, and I found a people ready to love me and my family. I cannot thank you enough for the opportunity to be a part of this congregation and family of faith.

I believe the greatest gift you gave me from day one, was the permission to be myself. You reminded me over and over that I didn't need to be anything or anyone that I wasn't. You reinforced my baptismal identity as a Child of God, and you invited me to simply be faithful in this call as your pastor.

You have prayed for us. You have celebrated with us. You have cried with us, and you have walked with us through the ups and downs of life. You have helped raise my kids, bury my father and my grandparents, and you have shown us the heart of God in how you have made space for us within the MTLC family. What's even more, you have allowed us the privilege of doing the same with you and yours. We have grown in our faith together. And I believe Irina, Abby Grace, Burns, and I are leaving this church a little better than we found it. Again, thank you for the ministry we did together.

I find myself going into the call to be Bishop of SC, with many of the same feelings that I had right before I came here. I'm so sad to leave the good people of Mt. Tabor. I am hesitant to vacate the office, pulpit, and altar that I have come to know so well, and feel so at home in. And with a little jealousy, I reluctantly hand the keys over to the next pastor, doing so faithfully knowing that God is calling the next one that you will love just the same as me.

I am excited and nervous to start this new position. And I do so with your support and love that goes with me and my family. I ask that you continue to pray for me as we once again step out in faith, knowing that Christ goes with us and y'all; knowing that the Holy Spirit binds us together, and knowing that God has all of us in His hand. “May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.”

Positively Fit: Body, Mind and Soul

We meet on Monday and Thursday at 5:30 in room 121, walking at 4:30. All ability levels are welcome! Variations of exercises are offered! Join our group. If you have questions, please ask Tammy O'Quinn, Brennen Hutto or Carol Busbee.

So, the temperatures are scorching and you don't want to exercise, what should you do? Exercise of course! You can choose exercises that are easy to do inside. If you just can't get a workout in unless you are outside, use common sense when the temps are steaming!

If you exercise outside, listen to your body but also prepare your body before you exercise outside.

Always avoid the hottest part of the day - 10 am - 4 pm. Try to exercise early in the morning or late in the afternoon. Note - high humidity does not allow your body to evaporate sweat, preventing your body from cooling itself.

Hydrate before going outside! Remember to take water or a sports drink with you when planning to be outside for any length of time. If you are replenishing your body with a sports drink, choose one that is low in sugar with electrolytes.

The sun's rays can damage your skin. Always wear sunscreen when you are outdoors. Choose products that are at least 30 SPF and are broad-spectrum to block the damaging rays. Remember to reapply!

Wear clothing that will help your body stay cool. Choose light weight clothing that does not fit tight to allow for ventilation. If you are in the sun, you may want a hat to block the sun from your face, but a hat does not necessarily keep you cooler since some of your heat escapes from your head.

Alter your workout plan. Shorter workouts and/or longer recovery periods can ease the stress on your body from the heat.

Always listen to your body! If you are feeling overheated, get to the shade, drink fluids and take a break!

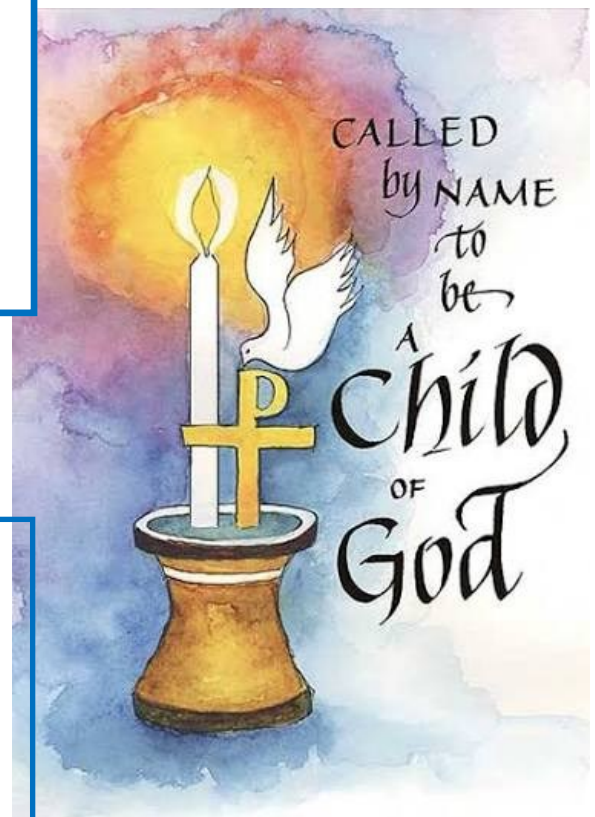

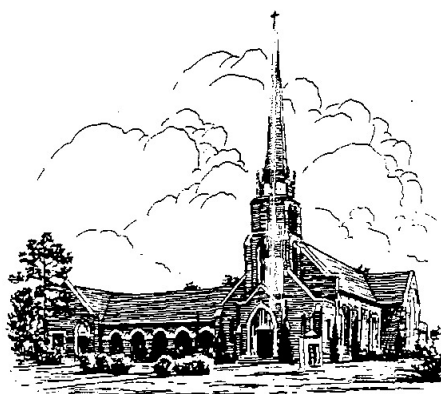
