

Job Description: Superintendent

- Address any cost overruns or budget variances promptly.

# 5. Quality Control:

- Implement and maintain strict quality control measures to ensure work meets project specifications.
- Identify and address any construction defects or deviations from plans.
- Collaborate with quality control and subcontractor teams to maintain high project standards.

## 6. Safety Compliance:

- Work closely with Addison Prime's Safety Lead to implement the company's safety program.
- Conduct safety meetings, trainings, and audits to ensure a safe working environment.
- Investigate and report incidents and implement corrective actions.
