



# **MODIFIED RULES** for Middle School & **Junior HS**

- A roster should be provided prior to the start of the game. Head Coach should be listed as well as players.
- Scheduled time is 2 x 35 minutes halves
- NO Periods or Quarters
- NO Over Time (OT)
- Both coaches can agree to less time.

- Schools should have communicated with each other about uniforms. Visiting team may NOT have white uniforms for away games, can wear colors. Home uniforms should have colors, should contrast from Away team. If conflict, use common sense (pinnies) PLAY MATCH
- Only molded sole shoes or cleats & sneakers permitted.
- Shin guards must always be worn under the socks. Players cannot play without approved shin guards.
- Goalkeeper OPTIONAL to wear boxer type headgear with a chinstrap. Also OPTIONAL is the use of a mouthpiece.

- Both teams must have 11 players on the field to start the game. Game cannot start with less than 11 players.
- Either or both teams may substitute when the ball goes out of bounds across the sideline or the end line.
- If a player is injured and cannot return and there are no substitutes available, that team may play shorthanded.
- A <u>red carded player must be substituted for</u>; they may play shorthanded if they only 11 players.
- THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF PLAYERS IS 7.

- Scissor/hitch kicks and slide tackles, which are not deemed playing in dangerous manner, are legal.
- Coaches are allowed 1 time out per half, which is 2 minutes in length. During their possession or on any dead ball. If it is during live play the restart would be a drop ball to the team that called the T.O. For instructional purposes only.

NOTE: ALL OTHER RULES FROM THE RULE BOOK APPLY!!!

### NO CHANGE to JUNIOR VARSITY games.

ALL JV Games are 2-40 minute halves.

SAME AS VARSITY.

JV = HIGH SCHOOL (ALL HS Rules Apply)

MODIFIED = Junior High School/Middle School (Modified Rules Apply)
