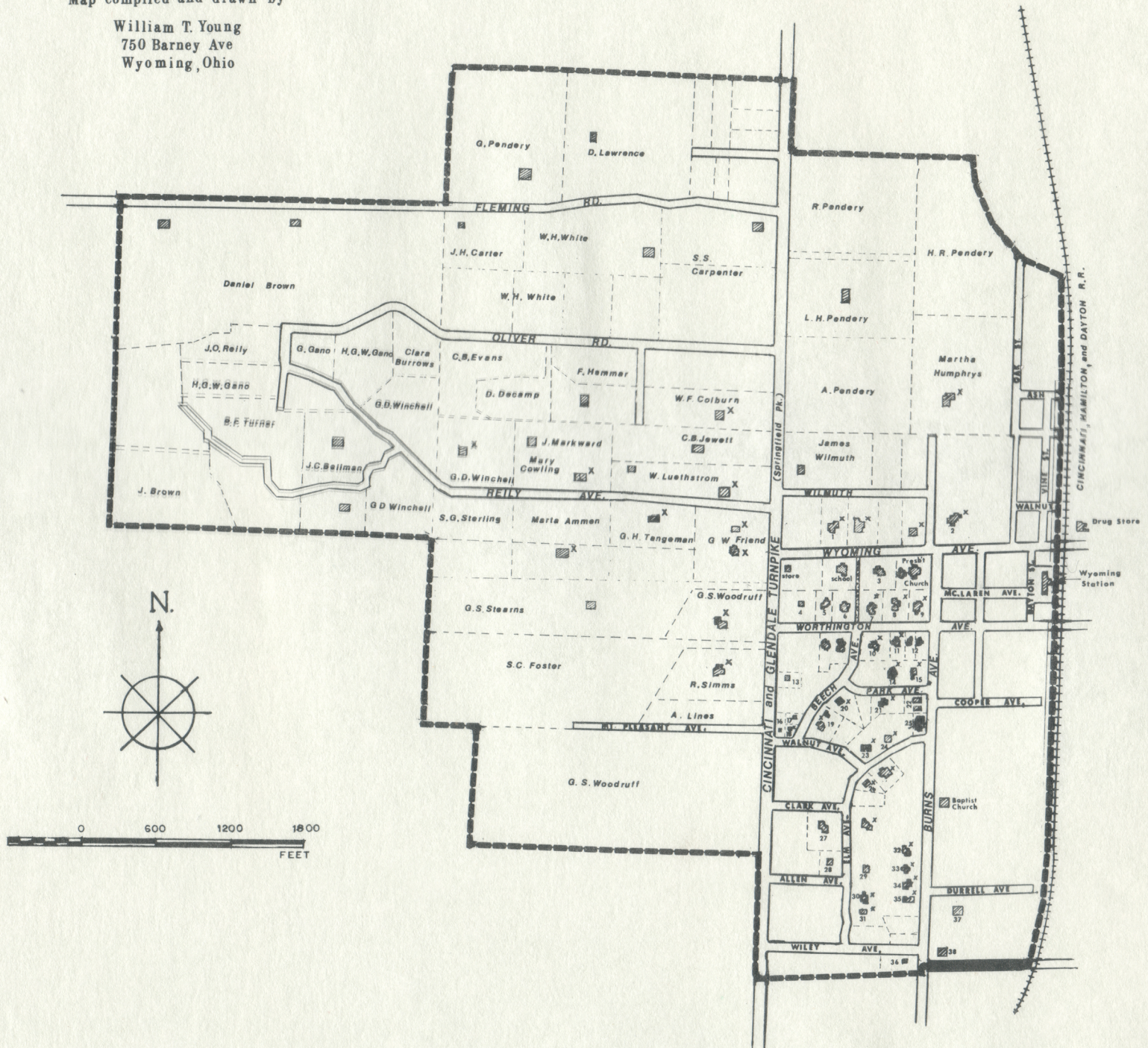

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Note: The portion of the Village roughly east of Springfield Pike and south of Wyoming Ave. was laid out in 1874 by The Wyoming Land and Building Co. whose subdivision was recorded Sept. 9 1874. The numbered houses in that area on this map were owned by the following: (according to records of The Wyoming Land and Building Co.)

For the rest of the Village, the lot lines and property owners shown were taken from a map which accompanied the original petition for incorporation of Wyoming, which was filed July 22, 1870.
