What is a deputy?

- A Court appointed individual who is able to make decisions on behalf of someone who lacks mental capacity

Who can be a deputy?

- Any family member or friend, above 21 years old

Why do I need to apply to be a deputy?

- When you need to assist the incapacitated individual with the management of their affairs and/or property

TYPES OF DEPUTYSHIP APPLICATION

	SIMPLIFIED	STANDARD
Applicant	Only family members above 21 years old	Family member or friend above 21 years old
Consent	All relevant persons to consent	Relevant person to consent/serve application on them
Amount involved	Not more than S\$80,000	May exceed S\$80,000
Court Orders	Specific Orders only	May request for other Orders
Filing Fees	Cheaper	More expensive

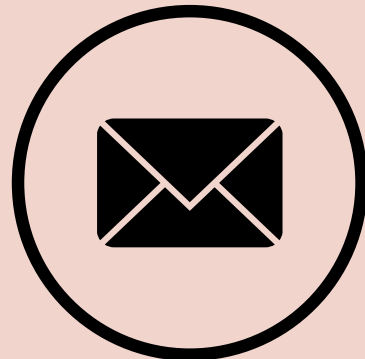
