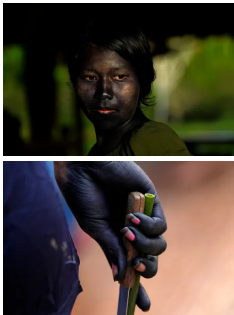

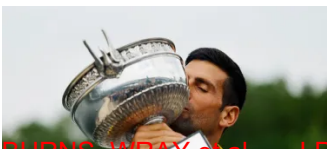

Using that approach one could say that except for traditional Social Security the entire modern welfare state has been created since the 60's which correlates with increasing income disparities.
