Where the doctors said she wasn't going to see, Sister Rhonda can see!

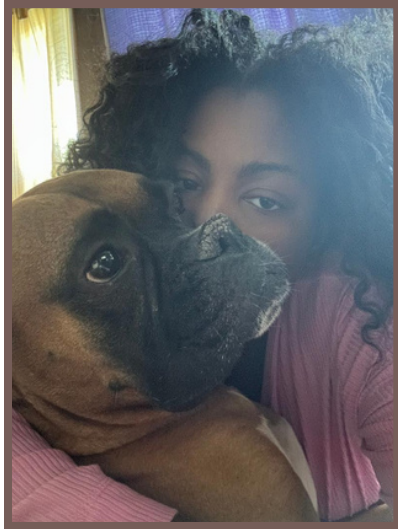

Leading up to the procedure, I felt uneasy. I prayed, but I didn't have the peace I've come to recognize as God's confirmation. When I finally received the call, I was told that instead of one toe, two toes had been amputated.

I was heartbroken and overwhelmed with guilt, feeling like my disobedience had cost Bentley more than necessary.

But even in that, God reminded me: He never left.

Bentley is still healing and adjusting, and while this journey hasn't been easy, God has been faithful every step of the way.

This testimony isn't about perfection, it's about truth. Too often, we let fear, shame, or doubt cause us to lean on our own understanding, even after God has spoken.

But God has not changed.

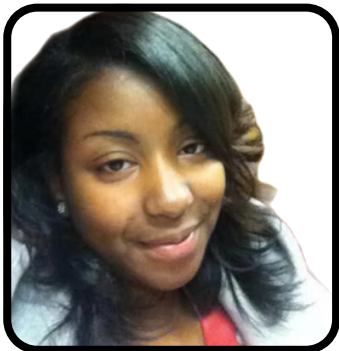
He is still faithful.
