

## Course Description

**How to Study the Bible** teaches the importance of God's Word and how to study the Bible effectively through observation, interpretation and application.

**Old Testament Survey I** is an overview of (Genesis-Esther) God's working from the creation account as found in Genesis to the early days of his chosen people as found in the historical books.

**Foundations of Christian Doctrine I** introduces the doctrines of the Christian Church which explain the foundation of our beliefs. Emphasis on the Doctrines of Revelation, Scripture, God, Angels and the Holy Spirit.

**New Testament Survey** is a summary of the life and teachings of Jesus Christ, the history of the Christian Church, God's plan of salvation and the Lord's return.

**Book of Acts** teaches the historical beginning of the Church of Jesus Christ led by the effectual ministry of His apostles to the Jews and Gentiles by the power of the Holy Spirit.

**Discipleship** (*Criteria for pleasing Christ*) is an in-depth study of "true discipleship" from spiritual, physical and emotional character growth pleasing to Christ.

**Essentials of Prayer** seeks to show the absolute necessity of prayer in the believer's life, -in developing the whole person emotionally, mentally, physically, and spiritually.

**Spiritual Warfare** teaches the believer how to dress for spiritual battles, how to use spiritual weapons and spiritual strategies effectively.

**Christian Psychology** will help the students see God as all powerful as they examine worldviews and learn how to apply biblical wisdom through scriptures and case studies.

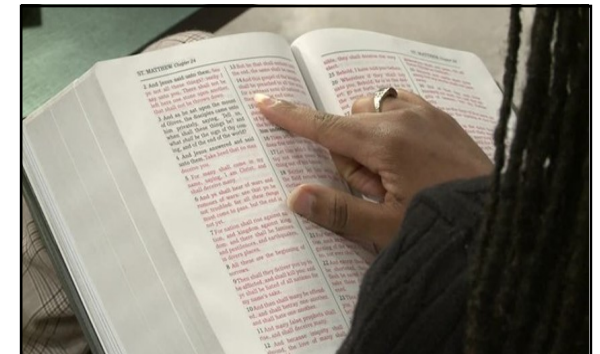

## PROGRAMS

### 3 - Year Biblical Studies Certificate

This program requires completion of four (4) classes during the school year (Sept. through May) for 3 consecutive years. Candidates for graduation must meet all requirements outlined in the school policy. A certificate is awarded at completion. Students with no previous bible school experience are encouraged to begin in September with *How to Study the Bible*.

**Classes are Monday evenings via ZOOM**

Courses for this program are:

#### **1st Year**

How to Study the Bible • Old Testament I  
Old Testament II • Evangelism

#### **2nd Year**

Christian Doctrine I • Christian Doctrine II  
New Testament • Homiletics

#### **3rd Year**

Book of Acts • Discipleship • Book of Romans  
Dispensations and Covenants

**Tuition: \$400 per year. Payment plan available.**

**Non-refundable registration fee: \$25**

### Audit Course

If approved, a student may enroll in 1 to 2 courses per semester (Fall or Spring) for biblical exploration and self enrichment only. **No credit is given upon completion of the course.** Student is not required to participate in testing, projects or required assignments but must attend at least 10 classes. Upon successful completion, the student will receive a Certificate of Participation. During the first month of the course study, it may be possible to move from audit status to the 3-Year Certificate or Advance Certificate Program with the approval of the Dean of Students.

**Tuition: \$125**

## PROGRAMS (cont.)

### Advance Biblical Studies Certificate

This program consists of two 12-credit modules. The program requires completion of four 3-credit classes during the school year (Sept. through May) for 2 consecutive years. **Classes are offered via ZOOM on Wednesday nights.**

#### **1st Year—Spiritual Warfare Module**

Believer's Authority  
Battlefield of the Mind

#### **2nd Year— Life of Christ Module**

Gospel of John  
Life of Christ

**Tuition: \$400 per year. Payment plan available.**

**Non-refundable registration fee: \$25**

### Individual Course

Student may enroll in 1 to 2 courses per semester (Fall or Spring). Requirements for the successful completion are the same as the 3-Year Certificate and Advance Studies programs. At the end of each school year, the student will receive a Certificate of Completion for each course successfully completed. Any time during the course of study, the student may change from the Individual Course Study to the 3-Year Program or Advance Program. Whichever is applicable.

**Tuition: \$125**
