

MESSAGE FROM THE PRIEST

ON THE OCCASION OF THE 30TH ANNIVERSARY OF ORDINATION, AUGUST 4, 2021

Dear parishioners, I cannot believe it has been exactly 30 years since the day I



knelt in front of the altar of St. Peter
Church and was ordained into the Order of Priesthood.
Three months later, on November 1st, 1991, I assumed my mission as Parish Priest of St. Peter
Armenian Church in Van Nuys, California.
As I reflect upon those beginning days I feel a sense of

rejuvenation today, and with this new revival of the Pari Loor Bulletin I can bring to you a degree of normalization, to strengthen our bond and communication further, in these ever-changing times.

It is difficult to put into a few words a recap of the last 30 years we have experienced together. A couple of years into my ministry, the Northridge Earthquake happened and our sanctuary and its adjacent buildings were severely impacted. We raised over \$2 million dollars to restore those damages. In the early 2000s, with the support of the Parish Council, various Church Organizations flourished: Church Choir, Gomidas Choir, Ladies Society, Fashion Show Committee, Saturday School, Sunday School, ACYO, and most recently, Sound of Children Arts School. One of the most prominent times in our church history is our youth strength through these decades; whether it was in theatrical performances like "Fiddler on the Roof," or coming home with trophies from

Sports Weekend, our youth was the home to so many children in the San Fernando Valley. For many years, I had the honor and utmost pleasure to gather hundreds of campers from the St. Peter Church community and participate together in the weeks of Hye Camp in the summer. Whether it was at retreats, acolyte programs, or deacons serving at the altar, I first-handedly witnessed our youth grow in the grace of God; some of them into youth leaders, exemplary members of our community and even priests themselves. In the more recent years, we purchased the St. Mark property and expanded our footprint by 120%. St. Peter Church became the destination for Catholicoi, Patriarchs, and political Leaders of Armenia and the United States of America. But above all, St. Peter Church became the spiritual reawakening for everyone who entered and received sacraments of communion, baptism, wedding, bible teaching, and counseling.

In 2020, the Covid-19 Pandemic forced us to close the doors of our sanctuary, for the safety of our faithful. We entered the digital realm, where we now livestream our Divine Liturgy every Sunday morning. During the Pandemic, we also collectively experienced the war and aggression against Armenia and Artsakh; at this time we opened our courtyard and the church ushered in Armenian families and organizations to raise \$65,607 which was matched to \$131,214 in support.

All of the above events and occurrences are just a small part of the expression of our deep faith in God the Father, compassionate love of our Lord Jesus Christ, and grace of the Holy Spirit. We can do nothing without Christ. It is with the strength and power of the Holy Trinity that we are still continuing to shine forth and brightly. God Bless Us all and keep us and protect us under the shadow of the all victorious and Holy Cross.


Even 15 minutes of your service will be extremely beneficial and helpful to our preparation of the Feast.


