#### Where to come

The retreat is at Coastal Retreat Center on Isle of Palms, across the street from the beach with an easy access walkway. Coastal Retreat Center is owned and operated by the Lutheran Churches of South Carolina Synod ELCA. Check it out at: sclrc.com/coastalretreat.html

#### When to come

We have the Retreat Center reserved for the entire week of September 6-12, 2021. You can come for one night or six nights or anything in between – space permitting. Some will stay all week and others will come a few days. Suit your own schedule.

#### What does it cost

Costs are for rooms, food, and supplies. Your per person costs depend on the length of your stay and the number of people in your room. Below is an overview of the costs

Rooms will sleep up to four people and have either 2 double beds or one queen bed and a bunk. Each room as a mini refrigerator, private bath with shower, self-contained AC and heat. Cost **per room**, per night is \$90 and can be shared by up to four people.





<u>Food and Supplies Fee</u> includes 4 meals a day (early continental breakfast; cooked breakfast; do it yourself lunch; dinner). Cost is \$10 **per person** with children under age 10 free. This fee also helps with other supplies needed for the retreat.
