Wyoming County Hospital

Supervisor Becker reported that the hospital recorded a profit for the month of November. The critical care designation is still pending and should be finalized in February or March of 2024.

County Jail

Another section had to be added on to the County jail to allow for violent offenders to be separated from the rest of the population.

Water Operator Training

Supervisor Becker and Thane Wright attended a water operator training in Perry, NY. The training has to be taken every year. Town Attorney David DiMatteo was the fourth speaker at the training.

County Administrator Hired

Wyoming County used to employ a County administrator over 25 years ago. After the person holding the position was let go, Arcade Supervisor Doug Berwanger, assumed the duties as Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. Last week, the Board of Supervisors reinstituted the

position and hired former Sheldon resident, Scott Schrader, as Wyoming County Administrator. Supervisor Becker reported that Mr. Schrader has vast experience in government and is familiar with the accounting software that the County utilizes.

Public Water Service Line Surveys

A lead service line survey has to be completed in 2024. Supervisor Becker is working on the details of facilitating the completion of the survey.
