


Don't forget to sign up to participate in Ride 365. Be sure to also go on your HOG profile and assign your dealer to your Ride 365 information.



You can win a prize for first, second and third place for the most mileage. You need to be registered for Ride 365 to enter this challenge. This chapter challenge will end October 1st. Prizes will be awarded at the November meeting.

In addition, we are putting together a chapter observation ride to give you even more incentive to participate in Ride 365. The only requirement to participate in the observation ride is that you must be registered for Ride 365. While you are out getting your mileage you will be stopping at different locations (taking a selfie with you in the picture and the location name) and earning points. The locations will be listed, and point value will be assigned on the entry form. Some locations are worth one point, some two and some three. 

If you haven't submitted your current milage for 2023, you must bring a photo of your current milage - your physical bike will do during riding season \bigcirc and your VIN number to the Dealership.

The Dealership MUST verify your miles for them to be added to the database.
