RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE: (Primary responsibility will be to cover the Mobile Clinic; Secondary responsibility will be to work as a Chronic Care Manager; Tertiary responsibility will be to cover in-clinic)

This position will be based in Hopkinsville. Duties include:

- 1. Coordinate the program of Chronic Care Manager with the providers and patients.
 - a. Works in collaboration and continuous partnership with the chronically ill or "high risk" patients and their providers, family, and community resources in a team approach.
 - b. Create and promote adherence to a care plan developed in coordination with the patient, Primary Care Provider, and, if needed, family/caregivers.
- 2. Documentation in EMR to meet standards of care and billing requirements.
- 3. Be responsible for the nursing needs of the mobile clinic services and coordination of the mobile clinic onsite services.
- 4. Take vital statistics of patients, including monitoring blood pressure, temperature, pulse, and/or oxygen and weight. In the event of an abnormal reading, the medical provider, supervisor, or other medical professional on staff will be notified.
- 5. Follow proper protocols to avoid the spread of germs, spores, and contagions which transport disease as well as any other tasks related to infection control.
- 6. In-house lab procedures.
- 7. Monitor medication utilization by patients, as applicable.
- 8. Administer injectable medications as necessary as prescribed by the staff physicians/APRNs.
- 9. Monitor lab and diagnostic testing, or complete CLIA waived tests as appropriate/required.
- 10. Input prescription information in the database as needed/required.
- 11. Engage in community marketing activities.
- 12. Provide in clinic coverage for nurses as required for Primary Care when mobile clinic is not in operation.
- 13. Assist the APRN/Physician in the management and coordination of care and follow-up of patients.
- 14. Assist the APRN/Physician as needed, provide health screenings and respond to medication calls/requests and pre-authorizations, as required.
- 15. Provide education/training to patients either individually or in groups.
- 16. Assist with histories, physicals and gynecological exams office procedures, as requested.
- 17. Assist patients with obtaining health resources and information as appropriate or assigned.
- 18. Documentation in EMR to meet standards of care and billing requirements.
- 19. Work with team of Physicians to streamline and improve patient care.
- 20. Populate patient history in EMR based on Physician notes.
- 21. Enter x-ray, lab, and/or diagnostic test results.
- 22. Prepare information for appointments based on the Physician needs.
- 23. Perform general typing for Physician as needed.
- 24. Ensure accurate and complete EMR for each patient.
- 25. Perform other duties as required/assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

LPN with at least three years of experience in a healthcare setting. Requires experience in supervising program operations. Must hold an active Kentucky nursing license, have a valid driver's license, proof of automobile insurance, and reliable transportation. Must pass a Criminal Records Check and a Sexual Offender Registry Check. Must present proof of a recent (less than 1-year-old) TB skin test.
