

**CITY OF SEDAN
MINUTES OF MARCH 18, 2025**

The Sedan City Council met for the council's regularly scheduled meeting on March 18th, 2025, at city hall, beginning at 5:30 PM, with Mayor Bryan Blankinship presiding. Council members present: Sharon Payne, Kathy Miller, Janice Fine, and Adam Clark. Angela Evans was absent. Employees present: Caleb Ironsyde, Raven Darnall, and Police Officer Devin Lumley. Public present: Wellington Butler.

At 5:30 PM, Mayor Bryan Blankinship called the regular meeting to order.

Sharon Payne made a motion to approve the agenda. Janice Fine seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Janice Fine made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held on March 4th, 2025. Adam Clark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Sharon Payne made a motion to approve the payment of the bills in the amount of \$65,240.94. Adam Clark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

- o Devin Lumley advised the council about the Ad in the paper for the mowing service as he might not be able to stay the duration of the meeting.
- o Caleb Ironsyde is requesting permission to purchase cold patch at \$80.00 per ton with a \$125.00 delivery fee which will be approximately \$2,000.00.

Caleb Ironsyde told the council about the restrooms at the park needed to be repaired. There are broken toilets, and it will be roughly \$3,000.00 in repairs.

Janice Fine made a motion to approve the work to start on the restrooms at the park, not to exceed \$3,000.00. Adam Clark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Janice Fine made a motion to allow Caleb Ironsyde to make purchase of cold patch not to exceed \$2,300.00. Sharon Payne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

- o Raven Darnall gave the February financial report to the council.

Council Comments-

Janice Fine made a motion to go into an executive session to discuss matters pertaining to the terms and conditions of employment, K.S.A 75-4319 (b)(1); regarding personnel matters of nonelected personnel; the open meeting shall resume no later than 6:00 PM here in the council room in the City of Sedan. At 6:00 PM, the regular meeting continued with no decisions made.

Mowing Service Bids for Ordinance No. 948-

Adam Clark made a motion to authorize the Chief of Police and the City Clerk to request bids for mowing services in accordance with Ordinance No. 948. Janice Fine seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Inspection & Flood Routing – Dam –

Adam Clark made a motion to except McClure's proposal bid for the Dam inspection. Sharon Payne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Amendment to Franchise Agreement with Waste Connections-

- Raven Darnall advised the council that Waste Connections has an amendment to the agreement as the original does not have the four roll offs included in the original contract. Jeff Chubb looked it over and stated it was good to be signed.

Kathy Miller made a motion to approve the amendment to the franchise agreement with Waste Connection. Sharon Payne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Cereal Malt Beverage License- Floyd's-

Adam Clark made a motion to table the CMB license for Floyd's pending the background. Sharon Payne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

First Aid Kits for City Facilities and Vehicles-

- Caleb Ironsyde wants to get first aid kits for the city vehicles to be prepared if something happens. Unifirst has all different types first aid kits. Caleb Ironsyde would also like an eye wash station at the city shop.

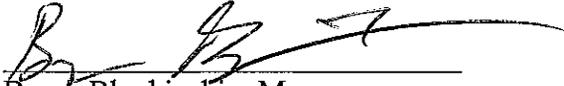
