

**CITY OF SEDAN
MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 4, 2025**

The Sedan City Council met for the council's regularly scheduled meeting on February 4, 2025, at city hall, beginning at 5:30 PM, with Mayor Bryan Blankinship presiding. Council members present: Sharon Payne, Angela Evans, Janice Fine, and Adam Clark. Kathy Miller absent. Employees present: Lana Robinson, Caleb Ironsyde, Raven Darnall, and Police Officer Devin Lumley. Public present: Wellington Butler, Joyce Moreland, Leroy Moreland, and Tim Hills.

At 5:30 PM, Mayor Bryan Blankinship called the regular meeting to order.

Janice Fine made a motion to approve the agenda. Angela Evans seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Sharon Payne made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held on January 21st, 2025. Angela Evans seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Angela Evans made a motion to approve the payment of the bills in the amount of \$88,220.30. Sharon Payne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Staff Comments-

- Police Officer Devin Lumley advised the council that it is a crime to have usage if the account has been inactive that would be theft of services.
- Lana Robinson gave an email to the council from the animal shelter regarding the talks of a public meeting about the contract.

Council Comments-

- The council set up a special meeting to interview for the public works superintendent position for February 6th, 2025, at 5:30 PM.
