The following Ordinance No. 597 was presented to the City Council on motion by Councilman Heinlein for their approval:

ORDINANCE NO. 597

AN ORDINANCE DEFINGING "WINDOW" PEEOPING" PROVIDING IT TO BE AN OFFENSE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDAN, KANSAS:

SECTION I. That any person who shall trespass upon property in the City of Sedan, Kansas, owned or occupied by another for the purpose of looking or peeping into any window; door, skylight or other opening in a dwelling, apartment house or rooming house shall be quilty of a misdemeanor known as "Window Peeping" and upon onviction therefor shall be punished by a fine of not less that One (\$1.00) Dollar or more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment for not less than one day nor more than three months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, and shall stand committed to jail until such fine and the costs of the prosecution are paid.

SECTION II. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and public/ation once in the Sedan Times Star of Sedan, Kansas.
