

**CITY OF SEDAN
MINUTES OF JUNE 2, 2026**

The Sedan City Council met for the council's regularly scheduled meeting on June 2, 2026, beginning at 5:30 PM at City Hall. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor Kathy Miller.

Roll Call: present: Angela Evans, Nathan Blankinship, Adam Clark, Mayor Kathy Miller, Crystal Wade and Wellington Butler.

Public present: Dave Taylor.

Employees present: Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde, City Treasurer Raven Darnall, and Police Chief William Tunstall.

Attendees recited the pledge of allegiance and Mayor Kathy Miller said a prayer.

Citizen Presentation/Comments-

Crystal Wade made a motion to approve the agenda. Adam Clark seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Wellington Butler made a motion to amend the meeting minutes for May 19, 2026, to reflect section A changing Highway 99 business route to Highway 166B and approve amended minutes. Adam Clark seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Crystal Wade made a motion to approve the special meeting minutes for May 26th, 2026. Nathan Blankinship seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Nathan Blankinship made a motion to approve the special meeting minutes for May 27th, 2026. Wellington Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Wellington Butler made a motion to approve the bills and payroll in the amount of \$65,862.74. Angela Evans seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Old Business-

a. City Hall Sign- Dave Taylor-

Dave Taylor presented a contract for the sign between Mary Simpson and the city.

Angela Evans made a motion to approve the contract. Nathan Blankinship second the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Wellington Butler made a motion to approve the sign as presented. Angela Evans second the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

b. Laserfiche Proposal

City council was presented a proposal from Laserfiche via zoom. The council was not in favor of the proposal but would like to look into other avenues for records keeping.

c. Mowing Bids-

City received a sealed bid for nuisance mowing from Edges Lawn Service LLC out of Cedar Vale. Mayor Kathy Miller opened the sealed bid and read out loud. The bid pricing was \$350 24" in height lawn and below and \$500 for 24" in height and above. The council had a discussion and no decisions were made.

d. Dam Inspection Proposal-

Public Works Superintendent went over the dam inspection proposal with the council.

Crystal Wade made a motion to table dam inspection proposal until the next meeting. Wellington Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business-

a. MOA Round Up Club-

Nathan Blankinship made a motion to approve the MOA with the Round Up Club. Adam Clark second the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

b. SOP Hiring and Firing-

The council discussed the SOP and were not in favor.

c. Sewer Reduction Account 1304-10989-

Crystal Wade made a motion to approve the sewer reduction for account number 1304-10989. Adam Clark seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

d. CQ Flood Plain Mapping

The Council discussed the CQ flood plain mapping and decided to publish a notice on Facebook and the city website.

e. Reimbursement Request Tourist Guest Tax- SAEDC \$294.40

The council was presented the reimbursement and requested that request go through the guest tax board before approval.

Still attempting to recruit for police officer position.

Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde-

PWWSD #20 is in the talk of a potential water rate increase due to equipment repair at the water plant.

Electrical issues at the city pool, Caney Valley Electric was called out and issues were repaired.

Lower diving board rail needs welding repair. Requesting the council approval of purchase of a 110 welder. The council is requesting bids for a 110/220 welder to put into next year's budget.

The city received a bill from AT&T for \$1,931.95 for phone lines that were damaged during a sewer line repair.

KHDE will be sending a representative out to the lakes and city park to do some research on ticks.

Council Comments-

Crystal Wade

Asked about the tree removal out at the fairgrounds. Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde met with Nathan Blankinship at the fairgrounds, and the city will be handling the removal of the trees.

Asked about the trails getting mowed, but due to weather they have not been able to mow.

Nathan Blankinship made a motion to purchase a smaller chainsaw from Linn's Air Cooled Engines not to exceed \$600. Crystal Wade seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Library grant is still pending currently with change orders on the contractor's end.

Mayor Kathy Miller-

Discussed with council that the league conference is coming up in October and it's cheaper to book by July.

Wants all administration in the office to be cross trained.

All the pool sponsorships have been completed for the month of June and now is open for the month of July.

Crystal Wade made a motion to go into an executive session to discuss security measures regarding discussion of such matters at an open meeting that would jeopardize such security measures that protect the public body or agency, public building or facility or the information system of public body or agency. The open meeting shall resume no later than 7:08 PM here in city hall at the City of Sedan. To retain Police Chief William Tunstall and Caleb Ironsyde. Angela Evans seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

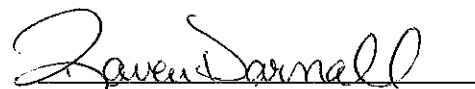
At 7:15 PM resume regular meeting no decisions were made.
