CITY OF SEDAN SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES OF AUGUST 31, 2023

The Sedan City Council met for a special meeting on August 31, 2023, at noon, at Sedan City Hall with Mayor Jack Warren presiding. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss street repairs. Council members present: Sharon Payne, Janice Fine, Bryan Blankinship, Adam Clark, and Tom Oast. Employees present: Sherry Miller, Ralene Davis, John Miller, and Leslie McGuire. Guests present: Darrel Blankinship, Kathy Miller, Crystal Wade, Wellington Butler, John Peterson, Angie Evans, and Breanna Avalos.

Mayor Warren explained that the city has consulted with four different paving companies up to this point. The city must carefully consider the cost, which streets would be given priority, the amount of funds that could be utilized from the Appleby donation, as well as what would be logical to retain for potential cost-share projects.

On August 30, 2023, A to Z Asphalt toured the city with the mayor and some of the city crew employees. Several roads were identified to be a priority, and a quote was provided. A to Z Asphalt quoted the city at \$1.80 per square foot, including milling. They informed us that since they are already in our area doing work, this quote gives us a \$3,000.00 to \$5,000.00 savings. The mayor estimates that one 300 foot stretch of street, depending on the width, would cost approximately \$16,000.00 to \$20,000.00. Focusing on the worst areas, which encompasses about 8-10 blocks, would cost roughly \$175,000.00. The deadline to respond to the quote is September 1, 2023.

Adam Clark made a motion to hire A to Z Asphalt for street improvements and to spend up to \$175,000.00 of Appleby funds. The final decision on which streets will be affected is still to be determined. Janice Fine seconded the motion. Motion carried.
