

ORDINANCE NO. 920

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING WATER SERVICE AND SANITARY SEWER SERVICE REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF SEDAN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDAN, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. All owners, occupants, tenants, businesses, or persons in charge of any occupied property within the city limits of the City of Sedan, Kansas, are required to have city water and city sanitary services, however, they are not required to have services turned on. If the property is occupied the minimum water and sewer charges will be assessed.

SECTION 2. There shall be no water wells used for potable drinking water within the city limits of the City of Sedan, Kansas. However, all residences and businesses may use existing water wells for watering gardens, lawns, geothermal, etc.

SECTION 3. The drilling or digging of new potable water wells for domestic use is strictly prohibited.

SECTION 4. There shall be no new septic tanks installed in the City of Sedan.

SECTION 5. Prior to a citation being issued, the City will mail a certified letter advising the owners, occupants, tenants, or persons in charge that they have 30 days to correct the violation of Ordinance No. 920.

SECTION 6. A violation of the terms of this Ordinance may be subject to a notice to appear in the Sedan Municipal Court, and if convicted, is subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 and/or a jail sentence not to exceed ten (10) days.

SECTION 7. Ordinance No. 918 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. An ordinance summary shall be published in the Prairie Star, the official city newspaper, on the 10th day of April, 2019. A complete copy of this ordinance shall be posted on the City's official city website. It shall be in effect and be in force after April 10, 2019.
