

**CITY OF SEDAN
MINUTES OF JUNE 16, 2026**

The Sedan City Council met for the council's regularly scheduled meeting on June 16, 2026, beginning at 5:30 PM at City Hall. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor Kathy Miller.

Roll Call: present: Angela Evans, Nathan Blankinship, Adam Clark, Mayor Kathy Miller, and Wellington Butler. Absent: Crystal Wade.

Public present: none.

Employees present: Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde, City Treasurer Raven Darnall, and Police Chief William Tunstall.

Attendees recited the pledge of allegiance and Wellington Butler said a prayer.

Citizen Presentation/Comments-

Angela Evans made a motion to approve the agenda. Nathan Blankinship seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Angela Evans made a motion to approve the meeting minutes for June 2nd, 2026. Wellington Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Wellington Butler made a motion to approve the bills and payroll in the amount of \$97,449.34. Nathan Blankinship seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Old Business-

a. Dam Inspection Proposal-

Adam Clark made a motion to accept the Dam Inspection Proposal for \$4,850.00. Wellington Butler second the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

b. KDOT Connecting Link Contract

Wellington Butler made a motion to approve the connecting link contract with KDOT. Adam Clark seconded the motion. Nathan Blankinship obtained. The motion passed 0 Nay to 3 Yay votes.

c. Reimbursement Request- SAEDC \$291.40-

SAEDC requesting reimbursement for the barn quilt tour handouts. It was approved by the tourist guest tax board.

Angela Evans made a motion to approve the reimbursement to SAEDC in the amount of \$291.40 from the tourist guest tax funds. Wellington Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business-

a. Public Works 99 Ford Repairs-

Mayor Kathy Miller approved Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde to get the 99 Ford fixed at Main Street Auto that exceeded the \$500.00 limit and was \$856.00 needed to get it fixed.

Put the Ordinance for purchasing on the next agenda to discuss the limits on purchasing and repairs.

Adam Clark made a motion to approve the repairs on the 99 Ford. Wellington Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

b. May Financial Review-

The city Treasurer Raven Darnall gave the council the May financial review.

c. Core & Main Auto Read Software Support-

The meter reading software support is due for \$4,000.00. This is a yearly payment and will start going up by 5% each year moving forward. There will be an upgrade to the software soon.

Angela Evans made a motion to approve the Core & Main auto-read software for \$4,000.00. Adam Clark seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

d. Fall Clean Up-

The fall clean up is scheduled for September 11th – 12th. The city will get two roll offs and citizens must show proof of residence in city limits. The city will pick up for the elderly and handicap. The council would like pricing on a third dumpster.

Wellington Butler made a motion to approve the dates of September 11th and the 12th for the fall clean up. Adam Clark seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

e. Need to Add Donita Buhler to Bank Accounts-

Wellington Butler made a motion to add Donita Buhler to all city bank accounts. Angela Evans seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Department Reports-

Police Chief- William Tunstall-

Animal Control vehicle needs repairs to the brakes. The break lights stay on when vehicle is on.

City Treasurer Raven Darnall-

Would like to look at the solid waste ordinance to make sure the citizens are properly charged for multiple properties.

Asked the council if all city employees could have the door code for city hall.

Wellington Butler made a motion to go into an executive session to discuss security measures regarding discussion of such matters at an open meeting that would jeopardize such security measures that protect the public body or agency, public building or facility or the information system of public body or agency. The open meeting shall resume no later than 6:30 PM here in city hall at the City of Sedan. To retain Police Chief William Tunstall, Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde, and City Treasurer Raven Darnall. Angela Evans seconded the motion. Adam Clark Nay and 3 Yay.

At 6:30 PM, back in open session, no decisions were made.

Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde-

FAA inspector came and inspected the Airport June 13th and gave some suggestions of replacing the windsock, lights at the end of the runway need corrected, trees along the fence line need to be cleared, and Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde is now the airport manager.

Road grader is in the process of getting repaired and they are on the right track.

Street sweeper needs new tires that will cost approximately \$250.00 and would like to replace both rear tires. The front two are decent.

Would like bids from C & L Tire and Main Street Auto for the street sweeper tires.

Nathan Blankinship-

Cody Bracken with the Round Up Club has been working out at the rodeo arena and it looks good.

Asked if the fish feeders have been pulled from the lake. Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde stated he has other priorities and has not been able to get them out of the water yet.

Adam Clark-

Adam Clark made a motion to allow all city employees the access code to city hall door. Wellington Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Wellington Butler-

Asked for update on Jeff Hull Paving. Public Works Superintendent Caleb Ironsyde has been in contact with Jeff Hull, and they had some equipment break down and he will be back next week to finish Elm from School Street to Delilah Street.

Mayor Kathy Miller-

Discussed with Public Works Superintendent about the millings and where they should go.

Thanked Nathan Blankinship for assisting public works with the diving board repair.

Flood plain open house Jun 17th, 2026, at the new gym at the high school.

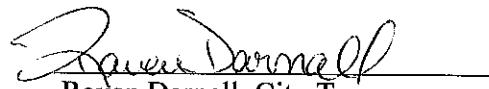
At 6:50 PM resume regular meeting no decisions were made.
