

**CITY OF SEDAN
MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 16, 2025**

The Sedan City Council met for the council's regularly scheduled meeting on September 16th, 2025, beginning at 5:30 PM, with Mayor Bryan Blankinship presiding in the 4-H building. Council members present: Janice Fine, Adam Clark, Angela Evans, and Kathy Miller. Employees present: Lana Robinson, Caleb Ironsyde, Raven Darnall. Public present: Joyce Moreland, and Leroy Moreland.

Mayor Bryan Blankinship called the public revenue neutral rate hearing to order. No citizen in attendance nor any member of the council wished to discuss the revenue neutral rate further. Kathy Miller made a motion to exceed the revenue neutral rate and adopt Resolution #25-03. Angela Evans seconded the motion. Roll call vote all Nay, with a no vote for Pam Koerner due to absence. Motion not passed and Resolution #25-03 not passed.

Mayor Bryan Blankinship closed the revenue neutral rate hearing at 5:31 PM.

Mayor Bryan Blankinship called the public budget hearing to order at 5:31 PM. No citizen in attendance nor any member of council wished to discuss the 2025 budget further. Adam Clark made a motion to approve the 2026 budget with adjustments to maintain the RNR. Kathy Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor Bryan Blankinship closed the budget hearing at 5:33 PM.

At 5:33 PM, The regular meeting was called to order by Mayor Bryan Blankinship.

Janice Fine made a motion to approve the agenda for September 16, 2025. Angela Evans seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Janice Fine made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held on September 2nd, 2025. Kathy Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Angela Evans made a motion to approve the payment of the bills in the amount of \$158,991.01. Adam Clark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

She is looking into other alternatives.

- Caleb Ironsyde stated he met up with Cameron Williams who stated he was working on the posts for the docks and cement to dry.

Adam Clark made a motion to appoint Kathy Miller as voting delegate for the Kansas League of Municipalities. Angela Evans seconded the motion. Motion carried.

- Janice Fine stated she spoke with Jeff Chubb about the body cam footage that was brought to the public's attention and stated the Jeff Chubb said it should not be released.

- Treasurer Raven Darnall gave the August Financial Report to the council.


Sewer Reduction Form Account# 1481-11063
