Stampede Steel has taken the "S" curve alley concept and made it user-friendly. Single "S" Alleys move in a parallel fashion with adjustments for young calves, cows and mature bulls.

Both sides of the alley move in with equal pressure, allowing the system to operate smoothly and quietly. Single "S" Alleys are built of one solid construction, and available with a variety of options.

Ranchers needing to run more volume of cattle, can add a Double/Twin Lead-In Alley between the Stampede Tub and Single "S" Alley, allowing for the cattle to flow into the system side-by-side before narrowing to the Single "S" Alley.

Stampede's innovative designs make working cattle hassle-free. The alleys allow for more of a natural flow of the cattle, making for a smoother work – requiring less manpower!

## MAKE WORKING CATTLE ENJOYABLE!

### SINGLE "S" ALLEY

The Single "S" Alley is available in 20- or 30-foot lengths with right- or left-hand controls, which are located at the front of the working system. The alley has four settings, ranging from 16- to 31-inches in width, which move parallel to each other and apply equal pressure from both sides.

Alleys can be designed to fit Stampede Steel Hydraulic or Manual Chutes. Available options, include: No Backs, Catwalks, Open-Sided, Double Open and Vet Sort Gates. Stampede has designed its Single "S" Alley so the safety for both livestock handler and livestock come first!

### DOUBLE/TWIN ALLEY

The 20-foot Stampede Steel Double/Twin Lead-In Alley has two 30-inch parallel runs that allow cattle to flow side-by-side through the alley. The alley opens the tub-to-alley area by 30 inches, so cattle flow through naturally, eliminating the need for more manpower to attend to balking cattle.

The Double/Twin Alley allows ranchers to process more volume without adding extra length to a setup. The alley tapers down to a single width, so the animals are able to enter the Single "S" Alley with greater ease and optimum flow.
