

Elementary SEPAC Meeting
April 26, 2021

THERE WILL A DISTRICT-WIDE SEPAC MEETING ON Tuesday, May 11, 2021 at 7:00pm. More info to follow with Zoom link.

1. We are looking for SEPAC reps from each elementary school - Please contact me if you are interested in organizing meetings at Coleman, Byrd or Hamilton.
2. LLD K-2 is moving from Coleman to Central to join LLD 3-5. (We still have not come up with better name than "LLD" which many parents dislike.)
3. PreK special education classes are all moving to Coleman school.
4. Extended School Year (ESY) will be offered to some students based on IEP. Goal is to prevent regression and review materials from previous year. This is the first time that this will be offered in district (in the past, students went to Mahwah for ESY). It will be in person. You will be contacted by Dr Mackay directly. Call her office if you have any questions.
K to 5 date/time: 8:30 am to 12 noon, July 2 to July 30
preK date/time: 8:30 to 10 am, July 2 to July 30.
5. Summer enrichment for reading, writing and math will also be offered for some students based on IEP. Dates/time TBD. You will be contacted by Dr Mackay.
6. Regarding ESY and enrichment, parent suggested moving schedule to later in the day after camps are over to assist parents who need full day. Mrs Lacroix suggested coordinating with community school to have a camp after morning ESY sessions.
7. Instruction supervisor for special education to be hired by the Board of Ed to assist teachers and parents with curriculum delivery.
8. Access to counseling is available through social skills groups runs by building guidance counselors and can ask for assistance from their child study team (social worker or learning consultant). Speak to Dr Mackay regarding specific situations.
9. For parents seeking accommodations in the form of 504 document, meetings are requested via school principal and should be arranged in timely fashion, though specific amount of time allowed is not specified as for request for IEPs (30 days).
