Notice is hereby given for the Old Orchard Community Association, Inc. 2023 Annual Meeting, to be held on October 19, 2023, at the Old Orchard Clubhouse located at 13222 Peach Orchard Ln, Richmond, TX 77407. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss Association business, as well as conduct an election of the Board of Directors.

There is one (1) position up for the Board of Directors this year, and your community needs your participation in the election! The Board of Directors consists of five (5) Directors, serving a three (3) year term. In order to conduct official business, a quorum requirement of ten per cent (10%) of all lots (62 out of 617) must be present either in person, or proxy-ballot. Voting will be held electronically this year by VoteHOANow. Voting Credentials will be emailed to you at the email address on file with Real Manage. (1 vote per property). If you do not have an email on file, you may contact Real Manage for your code. Real Manage may ask a series of questions to verify you are a home-owner.

Old Orchard HOA Assessment Fees

We want to inform you that after careful consideration and analysis, the Board of Directors has decided to implement a moderate increase in the HOA assessment fees. This adjustment is necessary to ensure the continued maintenance and enhancement of our community's common areas, facilities, and services. The new assessment fees will be effective starting January 1, 2024, and detailed information regarding the updated fees is explained below. We appreciate your understanding and ongoing support in maintaining the beauty and value of our community.

WHY ARE WE INCREASING 2024 ASSESSMENT BY \$150 TO \$1385

- · Previous increase was over 5 years ago, in 2017, when we changed our assessment to \$1235
- · Our subdivision is aging, and the upkeep & maintenance needs are rising.
- · Costs of repairs, maintenance, and basic services (landscaping, community lighting and importantly, waste disposal) have risen steadily in the last five years
- · Context favors the \$150 or approx. 12.1% increase after over 5-years of no increase
- The general inflation in the US since 2018 has averaged about 3.2% per year, and the cumulative inflation over the 2018-2023 period is north of 20%, meaning your dollar in 2018 is now worth 82 cents in terms of its buying power
- The property values in our zip code (77407 and larger Richmond metro) have gone up at 4.8% per year, and the cumulative increase in property values over the 2018-2023 period is north of 30%, i.e., your house is worth 30% more today than it was 5 years ago (still beating the general inflation)
- \cdot The six near-by subdivisions we have researched show an average 2-year assessment increase of 10%, with a range of 5% on the low end and 23% on the high end

School Zone Driving Safety Tips

- Be on the lookout for school zone signals and ALWAYS obey the speed limits.
- When entering a school zone, be sure to slow down and obey all traffic laws.
- Always stop for school busses that are loading or unloading children.
- Watch out for school crossing guards and obey their signals.
- Be aware of and watch out for children near schools, bus stops, sidewalks, in the streets, in school parking lots, etc.
- Never pass other vehicles while driving in a school zone.
- Never change lanes while driving in a school zone.
- Never make U-Turns while driving in a school zone.
- Never text while driving in a school zone.
- Avoid using a cell phone, unless it is completely hands-free, while driving in a school zone.
- Unless licensed to do so, never use handicap or emergency vehicle lanes or spaces to drop off or pick up children.

REMINDER: You must submit a variance request for every day you need to park on the street.

Remember To Dial 8-1-1

Building a deck? Planting a tree? 811 is the number you should call before you begin any digging project. A federally-mandated national "Call Before You Dig" number, 811 was created to help protect you from unintentionally hitting underground utility lines while working on digging projects.

Make a call for every digging job – even small projects like planting trees or shrubs. If you hit an underground utility line while digging, you can harm yourself or those around you, disrupt service to an entire neighborhood and potentially be responsible for fines and repair costs. According to data collected by CGA, when an individual makes a call to 811 before digging, damage occurs less than 1 percent of the time.
