- Fences: Height not to exceed 6 feet, Cedar pickets only. Please review the Deed Restrictions located on the web portal for more information.
- Roofs: Must be exact match to existing roof for small repairs, if replacing the entire roof, it must be the same roofing material as before, colors allowed: Weathered Wood or darker.

Exciting News! Ezee Fiber Coming to Our Neighborhood!

Dear Neighbors,

We are writing to share some exciting news! Ezee Fiber, a leading internet service provider known for its high-speed fiber optic connections, has announced plans to bring their services to our neighborhood. This provides yet another option to our neighbors for fast reliable internet service.

Typically, the process is described below.

- Install underground fiber optic cables using trenching methods that minimize damage to your landscaping.
- Restore your front yard as much as possible upon completion.
- Work efficiently to complete the installation process quickly.

It is expected that the installation process for laying the optical fiber and associated switches will commence approximately at the beginning of July. The work across our neighborhood is expected to take about six weeks in total. The actual work will likely happen during Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9 am through 4 pm.

Ezee Fiber will provide you with a detailed schedule and information (once finalized) on what to expect before they begin work on your property.

Next Steps:

Keep an eye out for further communication from Ezee Fiber with specific details about the installation process and service packages available. In the meantime, you can visit their website at [Ezee Fiber website] to learn more about their services and potentially pre-register your interest.


Fall Community Garage Sale - Declutter and Make a Buck!
