men at Bingham. Hes leaving
for the Army next Sat.

Kay and I are going out to see Joe & Lucy and were supposed to meet Maier & Em at the gam bar at 11:30. Well Jack Arnold got home on his pasture. He was here 8 days. We left Fri noon and I had a telegram from him tonight saying he arrived back there safe at 5:30 tonight. We had a swell time while he was here.

We went to the Big Barn last Sat nite. The crowd isn't the same tho just a bunch of high school kids there. And we had our Thanks-giving dinner at Lindens. They had 19 there for dinner, some crowd. and it

was just there family at that. Well Jack how's the Army? I suppose they do keep you busy. I send that underwear and stuff today. So let us know if you get it o.k. And also if you want us to send you another union suit.

Aunt Katherine went to the hospital again today for a radium treatment. It costs \$200.00 per treatment. I only hope it helps her. Mom didn't come out to Jack's with us tonight as she's too tired and she has to clean the chicken yet.

Mom says Hello and to take care of yourself.

I'm finishing this letter out
at Joe's. Kay is in the
bedroom talking to Joe

I guess everyone is gone
