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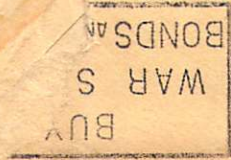

We were surely
glad to hear from you.
Sat. mte, I was washing
the dishes when you called.
And your picture is real
nice Jack, but if you get
home on a furlough I'd
like to have you go down
to Stans on 25th near
Clark to have a picture
taken. They do swell work
and reasonable too. I had
Arnolds pictures taken there
when he was home in Nov.
And they turned out real
nice. Marion thinks you
look like Jimmie Stewart
on the picture. And we

told her that you've been told that before. None of us think that she does you justice tho. But its nice tho. We have it standing on the radio.

Did Mom tell you she got a check from the government Sat? I suppose she told you. We played pinochle Sat nite Em brought some wine & salted peanuts over.

and Craven & Jo stayed home, so we played 2 tables Mom & Billy played too.

We each put 10¢ in & Mom won 2nd prize 30¢ and Maie won 1st 50¢. We went over to Aunt Josephine's Sun. afternoon. Em & Maie drove us over. Mom, Marion I & Gail, Marion's little girl went.

We had supper at their house stuffed cabbage and some real good bakery with nuts & coffee. Mom went over to Aunt Theresa's after we ate and she went to the happy death society at 7:30. Mom said Aunt Theresa is better now. She's been doing her own cooking the last 2 weeks.

The Dr wants her to go out but she hasn't yet as its so slippery out. We've had a lot of snow so far this year. But we still didn't have a white Xmas.

We went home from Aunt Josephines about 8:30 as Jo called up and said we should come home as Lucy Al & Barb & Charlie

were over with their tribes,
and they wanted to see
Marion & Gail. Did you
remember Marion's varce
jack? We had home made
pork sausages for dinner
yesterday. Mom made them
and were they good.
we couldn't get a chicken
~~last~~^{Sat.} night from the
chicken man. He had
them all sold out. So
mom ordered one for
next Sat. Honest the meat
situation is really getting
bad. We'll have to turn
into vegetarians. Well! Jack
Take care of yourself and
you keep on writing like
you have a mom worries
when she doesn't hear from
you. I try to write to you
at least a couple of times
a week.

Because I was in Chicago
for 3 months when I was
in the accident that
time and I know how
welcome mail from
home is. Do Lucy & Paul
ever write to you Jack?
I hate to ask them and
I was just wondering.

You should see Gail
Jack she's $3\frac{1}{2}$ yrs old and
is she ever smart.

Billy likes her, she's so
smart. not a bit bashful.
and she talks all day
long. Jack is it necessary
to have your address

The Press. So far I haven't

done it. And I thought
maybe it didn't have
to be changed as you're
still in the same

Camp. Have you been
getting the Press regularly?
And how old is it by
the time you get it. 2 days.

I suppose - Well! Jack

I guess I'll close for now.

I'll write to you again
later in the week.

Until then I'll say Good By.
Mom always says Tell

and not to forget his prayers.
So don't forget them.
