 while I'm gone.

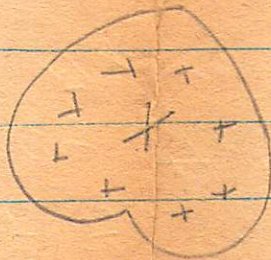
I went to watch Al bowl last
