I have a few minutes to spare down at the office so thought I'd drop you a line. How's the truck driving coming? You'll be through training soon won't you? Do you think you'll get a furlough then. Hope you do.

The weather here was beautiful yesterday & the day before, but today it's terrible rainy and dark.

Mom is feeling better now but Joe is sick again. He has bronchitis & a bad sore throat so that's the way it goes. It's always something. We're all kind of worried about him. I don't think he ever got completely

over that case of pneumonia. You'd better take good care of yourself Jack. One of the girls at our office has a brother at some camp & here we found out yesterday that he died. Nobody seems to know anything about it. As far as they know he wasn't sick. They said tho he drank some water that wasn't right so maybe that's what did it. Anyway Mom said to watch yourself.

I don't know what Craven & I will do tonite. We're sick of shows. He hasn't got a car you know so there's not much we can do. I think we'll go up (walk) to the Jam Bar. Maybe Marie & Em will come with us. — It's almost time to go home now Jack so I'll close for now With Love
