

Ice Box Cookies Sophia (Anton) Leisz

1 c. white sugar
1 c. brown sugar
1 c. shortening
2 eggs
1 tsp. soda
2 c. flour
2 ~~1/2~~ c. oatmeal
Raisins (optional) Try dates! choc chips
bushidough
Form into two squares brown and set in
ice box overnight. Slice.

335° 11-12 min
Bake 350°
12-15 min
(check often)

Ice Box Cookies (Anton's Sophia Leisz)

We did not have an Ice Box or refrigerator on our farm; we got a refrigerator in 1941, when we moved off the farm and into turtle Lake. Our basement on the farm had a dirt floor where it was very cold and dark. This was where foods were kept. This cookie recipe is good -- rolls can be about 2" on each side.

(German) Ice Cold Cookies

1 yeast (Baker's) { mix together and let stand
3/4 c. rich cream { 1/2 hr. til it rises.
1/2 c. sugar
add:
1 c. shortening
3 eggs (beaten)
1 pinch salt
Add enough flour to make a stiff dough. Mix well. Let rise again. Put sugar on board on top of dough.
