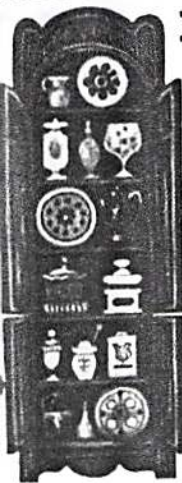

Here's what's cookin' Raspberry Ribbon Pie Serves         
Recipe from the kitchen of Aunt Ann Linden



- 1- 3oz pkg. raspberry jello
- $\frac{1}{4}$  c. sugar
- $1\frac{1}{4}$  cup boiling water
- 1 10-oz pkg frozen raspberries
- 1 T lemon juice
- 1 3oz pkg cream cheese
- $\frac{1}{3}$  c. powdered sugar
- 1 T. vanilla dash of salt
- 1 c. heavy cream

cream cream cheese vanilla + powdered  
sugar place on bottom of pie shell  
or graham cracker crust. Bake jello - when almost  
~~Set~~ spoon over cream cheese.  $\rightarrow$  just before  
(refrigerate.)

Serving whip 1c heavy cream until stiff  
peaks form. place on top of pie + serve
