The petition of Frank Leisz respectfully shows:

First. My full name is Frank Leisz

Second. My place of residence is number street, town of Turtle Lake Barron County,

Third. My occupation is Farmer

Fourth. I was born on the 30 day of April, anno Domini 1875, at Nemitzburg Hungary,

Fifth. I emigrated to the United States from Bremen Germany, on or about the 30 day of April, anno Domini 1893, and arrived at the port of New York N.Y., in the United States, on the vessel\* Norstad

Sixth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 9 day of April, anno Domini 1897, in the Circuit Court of Barron County

Seventh. I am now married. My wife's name is Barbara Hungary, and now resides at town of Turtle Lake I have 5 children,

Eighth. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Francis Joseph Apostolic King of Hungary, of which at this time I am a citizen, subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Ninth. I am able to speak the English language.

Tenth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for a term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since 30 day of May, anno Domini 1893, and in the State of WISCONSIN, for one year at least next preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 1 day of September, anno Domini 1894

Eleventh. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the Court of at on the day of anno Domini 1, and the

a petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit, and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition is my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Commerce and Labor required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
