the matter of the petition of John Leisz to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.

The petition of John Leisz respectfully shows:

First. My full name is John Leisz

Second. My place of residence is number 1 street, city of Turtle Lake Barron County,

State of WISCONSIN.

Third. My occupation is Farmer

Fourth. I was born on the 31 day of January

anno Domini 1861, at Nemetzburg Hungary

Fifth. I emigrated to the United States from Germany, on or about the 130 day of April

anno Domini 1893, and arrived at Chicago in the United States, on the vessel Somsted

Sixth. I declared my intention of becoming a citizen of the United States on the 7 day of September, anno Domini 1893

Seventh. I am single and have no children.

Eighth. I am not a disbeliever in the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to

remain a citizen of the United States and it is my intention to reside

permanently in the United States.

Ninth. I am able to speak the English language.

Tenth. I have resided continuously in the United States for a term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since

20 day of May, anno Domini 1893, and in the Territory of WISCONSIN, for one year at least next

preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 1 day of January, anno Domini 1896

Eleventh. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the

Court of Barren County, at Turtle Lake, Wisconsin, on the 1 day of January, anno Domini 1896

and the

petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:

Handwritten note on yellow paper:
John Leisz's son Joe was born at sea as the family were traveling to America. But on John's petition for naturalization, John stated Joe was born in Illinois. Probably to avoid jeopardizing the family's immigration status. The ship's Captain was very careful to note the exact time & place of the birth however as known on the attached documents.
