Thanks to Elaine and Alice for volunteering to be the nominating committee.

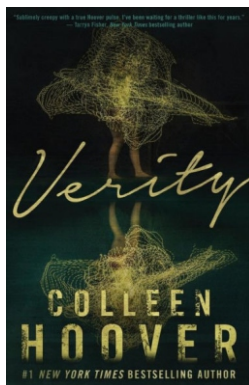
