Pads, tampons - all brands or sizes, especially teen size

Purse size packets of flushable wipes - ex. Stall Mates from Amazon

Paper Lunch Bags - red or black - to repackage items into smaller batches

You may purchase anywhere to donate or for convenience you can buy from Amazon wish list ~ Amazon Wish List - GCI Supplies.

Items range from \$6 - \$39 and will be delivered directly to Headquarters - pay attention to quantity needed:
