Rules:

This is a family friendly event. Scarecrows can be humorous, lovable, whimsical, but not frightening or distasteful. WCOM has the right to reject any and all scarecrows we deem to be offensive or inappropriate.

Materials must be firmly attached to the scarecrow so that it can stand up to sun, wind and rain.

Scarecrows are to be mounted to the assigned light posts along Main Street. **Assignments will be given out on Saturday, October 1, 2022 at 9:00 AM at the gazebo. (Email us at MedfordWomansClub@gmail.com with any questions regarding early assignment.)**

Installation will take place starting at 9 AM on October 1, 2022 (unless otherwise discussed) and all entries must be registered and in place by 11AM. Scarecrows must face the shops NOT the street.

Each scarecrow must have a sign to identify the entry- Name of group, business or club - Category entered. Businesses may include logo on their sign. No other advertising or political statements permitted.

All entries will be on display until Thursday, October 27, 2022 at which time the scarecrows MUST be removed.

An entry fee of \$20 will be collected~proceeds of which will benefit our Feeding Families initiative. (Checks payable to WCOM)

Winners will be announced on Saturday, October 1, 2022 at noon at the gazebo.

Participants do not need to be present.

We recommend that you check on your scarecrow periodically to make sure it remains in presentable condition.
