



White Lake Boaters Best Practices

Don't Bring in Unwanted Aquatic Plants and Animals

Inspect your trailer, hull, and propeller for clinging vegetation—dispose of any material in a trash can and do not discard any plant material at the boat ramp or in the lake.

At home: **drain, flush and dry** live-wells and ballast bags and discard bait in a trash can.

Protect the Lake Bottom and Shoreline

Wakeboard in deeper water only at least 50 feet from No Wake Zone poles/buoys and minimize repetitive passes.

Reduce speed well before entering No Wake Zone.

Be Safe

Avoid high speeds at night and use your lights.

Personal Watercraft (jet skis) are not permitted on the lake from Sunset to Sunrise.

Waterskiing, tubing, or wakeboarding are not permitted from one-half hour after Sunset to one-half hour before Sunrise.
