

Dear Representative,

I am writing to you today as a deeply concerned North Carolina resident regarding the current conference report for **House Bill 328**. While I completely agree that our state needs to clean up the unregulated hemp market and protect our youth, the current 0.4 mg "Total THC" cap goes too far. It acts as a backdoor ban that will strip life-changing wellness products away from the citizens who need them most.

I beg you to reconsider this final text before taking a vote. Instead of a total ban, North Carolina deserves a compromise that protects both public safety and public health. I urge you to amend the bill to enforce a **strict 21+ age limit, robust retail penalties, and rigorous product safety testing—without implementing the devastating Total THC limit.**

Every single day, thousands of North Carolinians rely heavily on hemp-derived consumables to maintain their quality of life. This is not about recreation; it is about survival and relief. If this bill passes in its current form, the following vulnerable groups will suffer:

- **People with Special Needs:** Many families rely on specific cannabinoids to manage severe, debilitating seizures and behavioral conditions when traditional pharmaceuticals have failed.
- **Our Seniors:** Elderly citizens use these products daily to manage chronic pain, severe arthritis, and insomnia, allowing them to maintain their independence without the fog of heavy prescription drugs.
- **Our Veterans:** Many of our brave service members use hemp to cope with severe PTSD, anxiety, and physical injuries sustained while serving our country. For them, hemp is a lifeline that keeps them off highly addictive opioids.
- **Our Pets and Animals:** Countless pet owners rely on hemp products to alleviate severe joint pain and anxiety in elderly or sick animals.

If HB 328 goes through as written, it will force these people back onto expensive, habit-forming prescription drugs, or worse, drive them to an unsafe, underground illicit market. It will also destroy thousands of local small businesses, farms, and jobs that make up North Carolina's booming hemp economy.

North Carolina deserves smart regulations that help everyone. We can easily protect our kids by enforcing a strict 21+ age restriction, mandating child-resistant packaging, and punishing bad actors who sell to minors. We do not need to destroy an entire industry and hurt our most vulnerable residents to achieve that goal.

Please vote **NO** on the current compromise version of HB 328 and send it back to be amended with strict 21+ regulations instead of a total THC ban. Our veterans, seniors, children, and families are counting on you.
