

AHF Scavenger Hut

This scavenger hunt is designed for residents of all ages and is meant to be a fun way to get your steps in and find a few historic or scenic places around the village. You can do it all at once or take your time working your way through the clues.

How to play:

- Follow the clues listed to nine locations around the village.
- There are nine (slightly to very hidden) containers, one per clue. Look for the container (hint- they are peanut butter jars) at the clue site. You'll have to spread out further to look for the token jar: they're there somewhere!
- Collect one token from the jar and put it in a quart-sized baggie.
- When you're finished, complete the form with your name(s) and address and return the treasures you collected to the office mail slot with your form. We'll mail you a little something to commemorate your hunt. *(If you just had fun and don't need the prize, just say that you had a fun time.)*

The total mileage to traverse all ten clue sites is 3.5 miles, walking, (longer if you're driving a bike or golfcart and even longer if you get lost.) You can walk, bike or hike but to reach all the clues you will need to go off the road and into the parklands. Wear comfortable shoes and watch your step!

If you find the (slightly or very hidden) container empty, please let the office know the location so we can replace them. If the container is empty, it's okay to take a photo at the site as your proof of finding the location.

Start at Nutting-Wood Green near the playground. Here are your clues:

1. Once home to brave airmen headed to war,
this now hosts meetings and parties and more.
2. The former site of a little store in our town,
we use this now to post things we write down.
3. This tiny park has no sign to give it fame
but the surrounding streets are birdie names.
4. There's lots of fun to be had at the pool,
but in this body of water, "No Swimming" is the rule.
5. This woodsy place near the edge of our town,
is a place where Donkey and Shrek might be found.

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6. You might find people gathered in the park where it's clear,
take a sprint through this hammock and run like a deer.
7. Take a shortcut to where Acacia ends and
find a was a bridge built in 1997 by friends.
8. Into our biggest hammock you might need a rest
so take the shortcut, find the bench and pass this test.
9. Native plants make a place for butterflies to play
but this biggest of butterflies should make your day.
