RULES FOR USE OF AHF PARKLAND IN MELBOURNE VILLAGE BY ORGANIZED GROUPS

1. The AHF member/sponsor must receive approval from the AHF for use of the parkland prior to the event and have it recorded on the activity calendar.
2. The AHF member/sponsor must be in attendance during the entire event.
3. All people must remain on all paths and walkways. No one will be allowed to block paths and must respect the right of way.
4. The AHF member/sponsor understands that they are ultimately responsible for ANY damage to the parkland.
5. The AHF member/sponsor will notify the AHF office of any unsafe conditions in the parkland.
6. Parking is provided in the AHF parking lot ONLY.

The group/organization must understand that:

- There are NO toilet facilities available.
- ONLY the facility reserved may be used.
- The Sponsor/Group understands all participants use the parkland at their own risk and the AHF is not responsible for injury to participants or equipment during their event.

- _____ **Deerhead Hammock Memorial Park:** E entrance on Hammock near Live Oak; S entrance at north side of Nutting-Wood Green; W entrance at east end of Sheridan.
- _____ **Martin Woods:** NW entrance on Sheridan near W. Pine; SW entrance on W. Pine near Norman; SE entrance on Norman near ball field.
- _____ **Charles Griffith Red Bay Park & Lake Arthur Tippie:** NE entrance on Norman; E entrance on Hammock between Norman and South; 2 S entrances on South Drive, 2 W entrances on W. Pine.
- _____ **Nutting-Wood Green:** A wide open field across from the AHF Hall with a baseball field.
- _____ **Memory Garden:** Across from AHF Hall.
- _____ **Erna Nixon Hammock:** Entrances at Live Oak & S. Wildwood; at the bend on Live Oak; at Acacia near Wildwood; end of Sabal; end of N. Wildwood.
- _____ **Azalea Park:** Entrances at S. Wildwood & Crane; S end of Acacia; E side of Platt Circle near the north end.
- _____ **Wildflower Meadow:** E entrance on Indiana near Flamingo; W entrance on W. Pine near Sheridan; N entrance at north end of Flamingo.
- _____ **Ward Park:** Corner of Blue Jay & Ward Parkway.
- _____ **Fick Forest:** Entrances on Dayton, S of Bulletin Board; and middle of Savannah Drive.
- _____ **Old Hall Park:** Corner of Dayton and Hall Road.
- _____ **Dayton-Oak Park:** Corner of Dayton and Ward Parkway.
- _____ **Lake Arthur Tippie Park:** Paths from Hammock Road, Norman Drive, W. Pine Road and South Drive wind through pinewoods and open meadow to the lake shores.
- _____ **Sabal Park:** Two (2) entrances off of Sabal Road.
