WHAT IS A RESOLUTION?

Resolutions deal with the Constitution and General Policy of ACWW as well as international issues and create a mandate for action if passed by the appropriate majority. This should be of international importance, as all Member Societies are obliged to take action in support of its achievement. [See The ACWW Constitution 2023 and Bye-law 11]

WHAT IS A RECOMMENDATION?

Recommendations are suggestions to Member Societies for action, if they are passed at Conference and may only be applicable in some parts of the world. [See The ACWW Constitution 2023 and Bye-law 11].

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

Following the call to Member Societies for Amendments (Conference Information 5, sent 15 July 2025, deadline for response 26 October 2025) the Board of Trustees herewith propose some amendments to some of the Resolutions put forward by the Board of Trustees.

There were no amendments received to the Member Society Resolutions and Recommendations.

It is important to note that some of the resolutions received came from Area Conferences where they were proposed by Member Societies that are not currently members of ACWW. We wanted to honour the fact that these issues are of interest to ACWW members and so we have included these resolutions regardless of who originally proposed them (subject to the rationalisation explained in Conference Information: 5). Members from other Member Societies have kindly come forward and will be moving or seconding the resolutions in place of the original drafters.

The Board of Trustees has also undergone an extensive and thorough process of reviewing the Constitution and other governance documents, and proposes numerous resolutions to update and modernise these documents. They have added some amendments to their original proposals here.
