August 14 – Family Sunday including a hotdog and corn roast after the service. Please bring your family and friends along with a covered dish to share (and lawn chairs).



The Invitation to the Lord's Table comes from 1 Corinthians 11:23-26.

The pastor will lead you when to join in the following liturgy:

The Great Thanksgiving

Pastor: The Lord be with you.

**People: And also with you.**

Pastor: Lift up your hearts.

**People: We lift them up to the Lord.**

Pastor: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**People: It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

The pastor will continue in prayer. Join in when she says..."Therefore we praise you, joining our voices with the choirs of heaven and with all of the faithful of every time and place who forever sing this song..."

**People: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest!**

The pastor will continue in prayer. Join in when she says..."Let us proclaim the mystery of our faith..."

**People: Great is the mystery of faith. Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ is coming again!**
