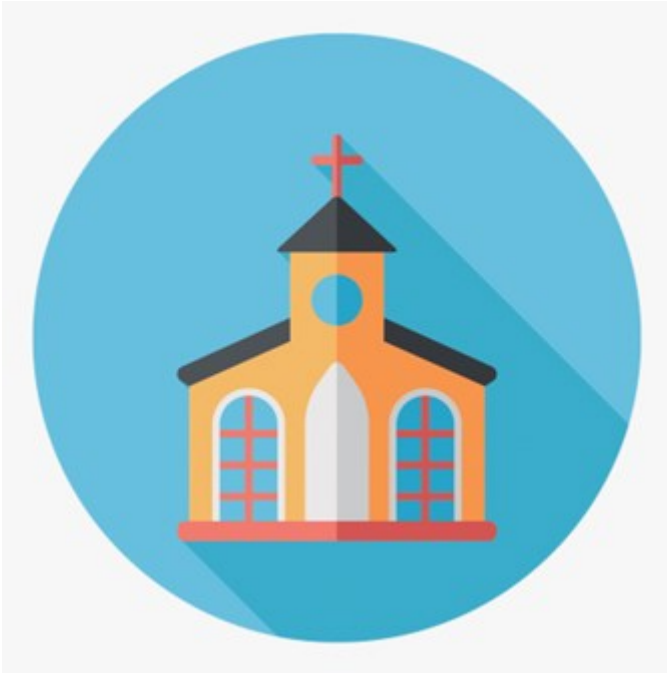

Remember

In our last Mass Book, we focused on the Good News that God shares with us. We learn Good News from Jesus when the priest or deacon reads us the Gospel.

Imagine what heaven would be like. Draw a picture of heaven. What awesome things do you think will be there.

Sometimes when we listen to the readings, we can start to look around, or think about other things. Try to listen, but if it is hard, look at all the artwork, the stained glass window, or the big cross. What are you seeing? Do you see Mary, or Jesus, or a different saint?



Watch and Listen

After the deacon, priest, or bishop reads the Gospel they say: **The Gospel of the Lord**

You say: **Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ**

Then they will tell us what that Gospel Passage means. This is called the **Homily**.

During the homily, the priest tells us how to live the Good News and honor God.

They give us instructions on how to make sure that we get to heaven. Try to listen.
