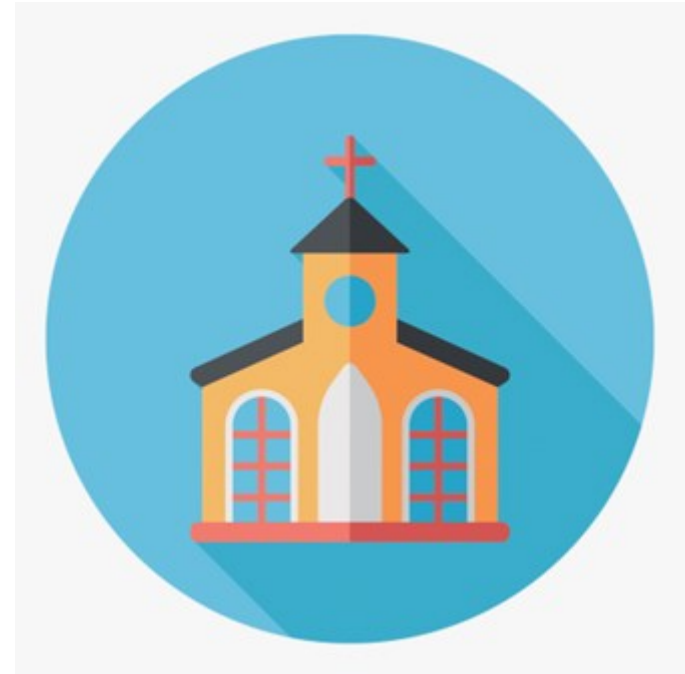




My Mass Book
