Review Questions for Tic Tac Toe - Group 1 (Answers are **bolded**)

Divide kids into two groups – Xs and Os.

Put a large tic tac toe board on the white board.

Ask a question (decide who goes first – X or O) and if they answer correctly, they can choose where to put their X or O. This can be done as a team or individuals. If they can't answer the question, ask the same question of the other team. If they get it right, they choose where to put their X or O. If neither team can answer, give them the answer, but no one puts a letter on the board. First team with 3 Xs or Os in a row, wins.

- 1. Who are you (in relation to God)? (This can be done as 3 answers they don't have to be done in a row can be mixed up, asking the same question to different teams.)
 - a. A child of God
 - b. A member of His Church (Catholic)
 - c. A son or daughter of a great King
- 2. What does it mean to be blessed?
 - a. God loves you and gives you gifts
- 3. When you 'count your blessings' what are you filled with?
 - a. Gratitude
 - b. Joy
- 4. What was the first Sacrament that you received?
 - a. **Baptism**; (do you know when and where you were baptized? Ask your parents to share the story of your baptism.)
- 5. What Sacrament are you preparing for now?
 - a. Reconciliation
- 6. What happens at Reconciliation?
 - a. We all sin sometimes and when we do, we get separated from God. This makes us unhappy. When we go to reconciliation, our sins are forgiven and our hearts and souls are filled with joy because we are no longer separated from God.

Review Questions for Ball Toss - Group two (Answers are **bolded**)

Sit in a circle. Toss the ball to someone in the group. Where ever that persons left thumb lands on the ball is the question they must answer. If there's no question there, they can get a pass, or you can have them answer the question closet to their thumb. If they can't answer the question, ask if anyone else can answer and then toss the ball to the next person — any where in the circle.

7. What is a sin?

- It's when we do something we know is wrong and do it anyway.
- It's **not an accident or a mistake** these are not sins, because we didn't mean to do them or didn't intend what happened
- 8. What other Sacrament are you going to receive this year?
 - a. Eucharist
- 9. Can you name the other four Sacraments? (Baptism, Reconciliation and Eucharist)
 - a. Confirmation
 - b. Marriage
 - c. Holy Orders
 - d. Anointing of the Sick
- 10. What are two ways we can thank God for all our blessings?
 - a. By being grateful
 - b. By **sharing** our blessings

Additional questions: **Sacraments of Initiation**: Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation; **Sacraments of Healing**: Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick; **Sacraments of Service**: Matrimony (Marriage) and Holy Orders Go to confession when you've sinned and want forgiveness and to be closer to God.

First Sacrament – Baptism – can only be baptized once Can receive Eucharist – once a day. Receive Reconciliation – as often as you desire

Review Questions for Wheel of Fortune (Answers are **bolded**)

Have kids sit at table. Take words as answers to questions and have them fill in the blanks (sort of like hang man – but better for church game). i.e. ask them the first question and then put 4 lines on the board, a space and four more lines Free Will fits the blanks.
 What is one of the greatest blessings God has given you? a. Free will – the ability to make choices b. God hopes we will choose what is good and right (Read the first part of the sentence so they can answer good and right.)
2. Because God has given us free will, what does He want us to become? a. Great decision makers
3. When we choose to do the right thing, who does that show we love? a. God b. Ourselves c. Others (these can all be done as one clue: 3 lines followed by a space, 9 lines followed by a space and 6 lines.)
4. How old was King Solomon when he became King? a. Twelve
 He was nervous about becoming King, so he asked God for this. a. Wisdom

Review Questions for Jeopardy (Answers are **bolded**)

Divide the group into two teams. Give the answers and teams have to raise their hands to ask the question—first hand in the air gets to answer first. If it's the wrong answer, the other team has an opportunity to answer. If both teams answer incorrectly, give them the correct response. You can keep score on the board — 1 point for each correct answer.

Example: You say: The 10 Commandments: The correct response is what laws did God give us to help us make good decisions (or something similar).

- 6. What laws did God give us to help us make good decisions?
 - a. The 10 Commandments
- 7. Who did God give these laws to?
 - a. Moses
- 8. The 10 Commandments they should be able to say which commandment it is.
