BSC PARISH COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES Thursday, April 10, 2025 @ 6:30pm | Parish Office

Call to Order: Bill Colson called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Opening Prayer

Approval of minutes: The minutes of the board meeting conducted on March 13, 2025, were presented. Motion to approve minutes was made by Ashley B. and seconded by Dave R. – motion passed.

Presentation of Reports:

1. President's Report

- Following the feasibility study report on Wednesday, March 26, the Pastoral Council was asked to vote on whether to continue moving forward on the restoration project. Recognizing that the report identified infrastructure needs as the highest priority by parishioners, there was discussion about satisfying that need while maintaining our primary focus on beautification of the church. Following that discussion, the council acknowledged that the beautification needs of the church will be the priority while ensuring that the infrastructure needs will not be ignored. The council then voted unanimously to continue moving forward.
- Parish Leadership Team update – Amazing Parish Program
 - Answers questions like “Why does Blessed Sacrament exist (in this place and time)?” and the answer was “to facilitate an encounter with Christ”.
 - Goals of improving the health and culture of the parish
 - Core values identified: sacrificial, openness, invested, loving
 - Anchors: reverent worship, formation and discipleship, and a Christ-centered community

2. Pastor's Report

- Letter will be sent to Parish members re: Feasibility Study
- Will take two phases to complete what parishioners identified as priority, and even then some items will remain unfinished (like Saint statutes).
- No bell tower
- Cry room – may be a need since current option will be unavailable

- Connecting of entrances – practical for conducting baptisms without interruptions
- Parking lot – trying to avoid intersection congestion with vehicles and people, especially Wednesday nights

3. Liaison Reports

- Adult Evangelization Update from Dave Raml
 - OCIA – one to be baptized and many confirmed at the Easter Vigil
 - Cor Ad Cor will finish after Easter. Discussion around how beneficial this program is no matter where you're at in your faith and prayer life
 - Bible Timeline, GIFT, both successful
