Dispatch

- ✦ No one should be taking 90 out of Enfield and bringing it through NY. You can use it to hop onto 88 but that is it. Same thing applies for Ohio, no one should be taking 90 throughout Ohio or Indiana unless otherwise told to do so by Jeff or Dispatch.
- ✦ ENFIELD DELIVERES – Please ensure you are getting as close to Enfield as possible the night before. Backhauls are becoming tricky these days and we have found that we need as much of your clock the next day as possible to make it happen. The less you have to driver in the morning of a delivery, the better off we all will be.
- ✦ Please be sending your BOLs as soon as you are loaded at the shipper as well as POD once you are empty at the receiver. Please be making this a habit as part of your in and out times.
- ✦ When working with split logs, if you are at a shipper/receiver for an hour and 45 minutes, please continue to wait the next 15 minutes in order to make it a full 2 hour break. If you don't take the full 2 hour break, that will ding your logs and put you in the red.
- ✦ Throughout the day, please be calling the office number 419-423-9555 for any questions/concerns you have. Someone will always pick up. The mobile is not monitored as much throughout the day and is to be used for afterhours please.
- ✦ Tablets are going to need updates real soon so please start bringing your tablets to Taylor so she can ensure they are up to date and working properly for you. If you have already gotten with her, please disregard this note.
- ✦ If you are reloading your empty trailer, please be sure you are sweeping out the trailers once empty and/or doing a complete check of the inside of your trailer the minimal debris. We are hearing more frequently that wood chip pieces are not being picked up and plastic is caught in the flooring. Please be sure to check prior to loading, especially since these trailers are not being brought through the wash bay prior to loading.
