BARN RULES & SAFETY AGREEMENT

1. Closed-toe shoes or boots are required at all times around horses.
2. Riders under 18 must wear a properly fitted ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet while mounted.
3. Riders 18 and older are strongly encouraged to wear a helmet.
4. No running, yelling, roughhousing, climbing on fences, or unsafe behavior around horses.
5. Horses may not be fed treats or grain without instructor permission.
6. Do not enter stalls, paddocks, or pastures without authorization.
7. Gates must remain closed unless directed otherwise by staff.
8. Follow all instructor directions promptly and respectfully.
9. Cell phones should be silenced during lessons unless needed for emergencies.
10. Smoking, vaping, alcohol, illegal drugs, or impairment are prohibited on ranch property.
11. Dogs are permitted only with prior approval and must remain under control at all times.
12. Unsafe conduct may result in removal from activities without refund.
