Students range from middle schoolers to graduate-level and their requirements are firm, including specific hours in specific roles. A general volunteer is anyone who wants to volunteer at UCP, but does not have a requirement to do so (ex. Education credit or parent support). These volunteers typically commit to a 3-4 hour period per week, coming in to the campuses and helping out with anything from administrative support to classroom assists to facilities maintenance; however, these volunteers can also be sporadic, helping with a special event or project once in a while such as Book Buds or the Evening at the Palace Gala.
